Scholarship Program for Cooperative Members



Are you a non-traditional student? Adult learner? LREMC has developed a program to serve those deserving adult learners, also known as non-traditional students with their dream of returning to school to further their education.

The **J. McN. Gillis** scholarship is for an individual planning to attend a two-year college or technical school. This scholarship is valued at \$2,000 and is available for a graduating senior or a “non-traditional” student returning to school and pursue a two-year degree.

We are committed to the people we serve and their families, and we are honored to be able to invest in the education and development of future leaders. We have high expectations for your success in the future.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: To qualify, you must be an active member of LREMC or member of spouse living on the system, 21 years of age or older and not a previous winner of LREMC scholarship. Applicants must be accepted into an accredited community college or technical school.

SCORING: Scholarships are awarded based on:

Personal Statement	25%
Work Experience	25%
Community Activities	25%
Need	25%

To apply, submit a completed application with two letters of reference and personal statement describing:

- Reasons for continuing your education
- How your school/community/work activities have influenced your goals and career choice

DEADLINE: Lumbee River EMC accepts scholarship applications beginning on the first business day of each year. Applications and supporting documentation must be received by close of business on the first Friday of the month of March to be considered for scholarship funding.

The scholarship must be used for educational costs, and the student must enter college in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is given. Checks will be made payable to the school by Lumbee River EMC.
